Nature of Survey Final entry

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the London Surveyors should be informed that this vessel is proceeding to this port for the purpose of being fitted with her machinery, and in order to complete the survey for classification the casings and skylight require to be riveted and fastened and made watertight after the engines and boilers are fitted. They should be requested to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work to their satisfaction they should report upon the same on form No. 8 for the information of the Committee with a view to the vessel's classification.
