Dear Sir;

The classification certificates of the steamers "CAUTO" and "PANUCO" were returned to me by the Superintendent of the New York & Cuba Mail Steamship Company, and it was pointed out that the plating of the vessel was different to that shown in the certificates. I at once took up the matter with the Surveyors at Seattle who forwarded to me plans of the vessels as built, and, in all the circumstances, I would suggest that fresh certificates be issued and dispatched to this office.
