Surveyed the ss. "K O E F I A" No. 74488 in Register Book,

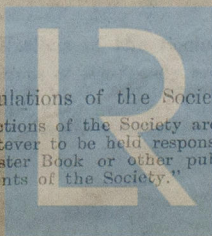
3823 tons gross of Naples for classification survey,

and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and that I have Recommended that she be worthy to be classed "100 A1" in the Society's Register Book with fresh record of survey 1-25 and notation of ss. Nap. No. 3 - 1,25 subject to 180 fathoms of chain cable being tested at one of the recognised Proving Establishments, 90 fathoms of stream being fit to carry chain or steel wire of proper weight and test being supplied, the hand pumps tested and ladder in holds repaired, being fit to carry dry and perishable cargoes.
