With reference to your letter of the 5th ultimo regarding the steamer " KOEFIA ", I beg to inform you that the Owners are very anxious to have the web frames in Engine space, and the pillars (one each side) under the quarter girders in hold No.2 dispensed with.

They state that two w.t. bulkheads are already fitted in the Engine space at an interval of 17 frame spaces, and that additional pillars in hold No.2 would caused serious inconveniences to cargo.
