
Dear Sir,

S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steam trawler "MERRIVALE," I beg to remind you that the Second Special Survey No. 1 became due on this vessel in May, 1931, but has not been held, and when the Committee had the matter under consideration in May last, consequent upon your intimation to the Society's Grimsby Surveyors that the survey would be held during the summer months, they agreed to the inspection being postponed, provided it be held without fail by the end of last July.

The Committee have again had the case before them today, together with a letter from the Grimsby Surveyors, who have forwarded your letter to them of the 8th instant, and in view of the fact that you do not propose to submit the vessel for the overdue Special Survey, they have had no alternative but to give instructions, in accordance with the practice in similar cases, for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Rules.
