Dear Mr. Morrison,

I duly received your letter of the 24th. ultimo addressed to Mr. Crawford regarding the approved plans for the above vessel, and enclosing a letter from the builders requesting that the upper deck beams and the floors may be approved as originally proposed, viz: 5"x 3"x .30 ordinary angles and 14 x .30 respectively, as this material has already been ordered.

I find on interpolating the tabular requirements that, provided the maximum un-supported span of the upper deck beams does not exceed 11 feet, the beams may be fitted as proposed namely 5 x 3 x .30 and that the floors may be fitted 14 x .30 instead of 14 x .32 as amended.

As requested I have cabled you to-day as per attached translation, and shall be glad if you will kindly debit the builders with the sum of Y7.60 the cost of this cablegram.
