With reference to my letter of the 1st instant respecting your steam trawler "WORSLEY", I have to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Grimsby have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 4th, addressed to them, from which it is noted that it is not your desire to keep this vessel in class.

The case has been submitted for the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today, and I am directed to say that, in view of your intimation and of the year of grace allowed for the completion of the 2nd Special Survey No.2, having expired last September, they have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
