In March last the Grimsby Surveyors stated this vessel was laid up indefinitely and that the outstanding surveys would be held before she again proceeded to sea.

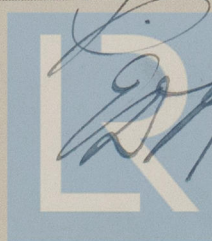
In May last the same Surveyors wrote that the National Provincial Bank Ltd., as Mortgagees, had full control of this vessel and that their intention was to offer her for sale. They forwarded a letter from the Bank agreeing to have the Boiler Survey carried out before she was placed again in commission or to inform intending purchasers that this required to be done.
