The Third Special Survey No.1 became due on this vessel in April, 1931, and no part has been held.

She has been laid up at Harburg since November 1930, and on the expiration of the year of grace (April, 1932) the Owners furnished the usual undertaking.

From information received through the Society's Surveyors at Hamburg it was understood that the vessel is now being used exclusively as a storage depot for lubricating oils at Harburg.

The case was submitted to the Classing Committee on the 9th instant, when in the circumstances they decided to recommend to the General Committee that the vessel's class be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof.

The case was reported to the General Committee on the 9th instant, who agreed to the vessel's class being withdrawn at Owners' request, provided a letter were received from the Owners requesting that this be done.

A letter has now been received from the Owners requesting withdrawal of the class, and the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Tuesday, 28th instant, decided in the circumstances to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
