ANSWER.

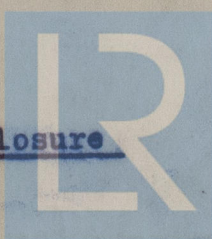
With reference to your memorandum of the 26th October last and the entry in your return of vessels under survey for the December quarter, I shall be glad to learn how this case now stands.

Date:— Hamburg, 24.2.33.

The Owners state that the s.s. "IRMA SCHINDLER" is for the present being used as a storage depot for lubricating oils. The vessel is lying Harburg. The Owners state that two boilers can with the approval of the Hamburg Boiler Authorities be used for filling and discharging and repairs have been made to the tank bulkheads, also to the cargo pumps and to auxiliary machinery. The Owners requested to advise us fully in regard to this matter and a translation of the letter sent is enclosed herewith. It will be observed that the Owners bring up the question as to the vessel's classification being retained while employed as a storage depot. All work that has been done by the Owners in equipping the vessel for her present employment has been carried out by them but not under the supervision of the Society's Surveyors.
