In reply to your letter of the 14th instant regarding the steamer "IRMA SCHINDLER" I have been in communication with Mr. Rosenbaum of Messrs. Tankschiff-Rhederei Julius Schindler G.m.b.H., Hamburg, who states that the vessel is lying at Harburg and negotiations are still taking place in reference to chartering the vessel for use as a depot ship in a German Port or in some port abroad.
