Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "IRMA SCHINDLER", I beg to remind you that the Third Special Survey No. 1 became due in April, 1931, but has not yet been held. In addition, the Screw Shaft Survey became due in April, 1930 and the Boiler Survey in August, 1930, and these inspections are also outstanding.

The Committee have had the case before them today, together with a letter from the Society's Surveyors at Hamburg, who state that the vessel is still laid up at that port; and in all the circumstances I have to say that as the year of grace allowed for the completion of the Special Survey expires at the end of this month, the Committee can only agree to the vessel's class in the Register Book remaining undisturbed for the present whilst she is laid up, subject to the conditions set forth on the enclosed form of undertaking, which I shall be glad if you will kindly sign and return to this Office.
