"IRMA SCHINDLER" Your letter of the 2nd instant received the careful consideration of the Committee to-day, and in view of the fact that the Boilers of this vessel have not been examined by the Society's Surveyors since August 1929 and the screwshaft since April 1927 the Owners proposal for the vessel to proceed to Italy without these inspections being carried out cannot be agreed to and if the vessel is to retain her class the Committee must ask that a complete Boiler Survey, the inspection of the screwshaft and all necessary repairs be carried out before the vessel leaves your port. I attach hereto my translation of my cablegram to you to-day, which is hereby confirmed.
