S. I have to enclose herewith a copy of a letter dated 2nd instant, which has only today come to hand from the Owners of the steam trawler "BASSANIO", regarding the Committee's decision to expunge this vessel's class from the Register Book with a Black Line.

You will observe therefrom that the statement that repairs were executed when the vessel was placed in drydock on the 25th ultimo is not borne out by your report No.43708, which definitely stated that the vessel had sailed without the repairs having been put in hand, and the Committee's action was taken on this understanding.

In view of the statement now made by the Owners, I have to request that Mr. Mackirdy will be good enough to investigate the circumstances closely and report thereon for the Committee's further information in the matter.


