With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "AGHIOS SPYRIDON", I beg to remind you that the Third Special Survey No. 1 became due so long ago as October 1931 and has not yet been completed.

The case has received the consideration of the Committee from time to time in connexion with correspondence which has taken place with Mr. Polychroniadis, who it is understood is your Consulting Engineer in London.

A letter has now been received from him stating that he has now heard from your London Agents that they are negotiating the sale of the vessel, and having regard to the fact that the only condition under which, in the circumstances of the case, the Committee have hitherto been prepared to allow the vessel to retain her class in the Register Book whilst laid up was that you would furnish the printed form of undertaking, which was forwarded to you through Mr. Polychroniadis on the 1st November last, and that this has not been forthcoming, the Committee regret

that they have now no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I may add that in view of the expunging of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard, together with the corresponding draught, assigned by the Committee, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
