In reply we have to advise you that the Owners are negotiating the vessel's sale for breaking up with delivery West Italy.

We shall therefore be glad if you will approach the Classification Society requesting them for permission for a voyage from Piraeus to the Black Sea thence West Italy, where it is proposed to end the life of this vessel.
