The 1st S.S. No.2 became due 11.31 and a proposal to postpone same was agreed to in October last provided it be completed not later than the end of December.

The Hamburg Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock and found in good condition.

It is stated the vessel has now been sold to Russia and will be classed with the Germanischer Lloyd.

The year of grace expired 11.32.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
