Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 22nd ultimo respecting the steamers "JAPIX" and "MBLITA" I have to advise you that a further letter has been received from the Owners which translated reads as follows:-

We received your letter of the 25th ultimo and noted that the special survey of our steamers "Japix" and "Melita" must be undertaken before these ships leave this Port. In view of the fact that during the last two years these ships have been in service only for a period of less than one year we would be very glad if you could again take up the matter with the Committee of Lloyd's Register in London and enquire whether the Committee would be agreeable to postpone the carrying out of the special survey for a period of one year. If required, opportunity will be afforded to you to assure yourselves of the excellent condition of these ships."
