Sir.

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 12th inst, enclosing a Copy of a letter which you have received from the Societys Surveyor at Huddlesbrough, together with a Copy of the letter advised therein, respecting 240 Faths of 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " cable, Tipton Certificate of Test No 58041.

I believe that two divided Certificates (Not "amended" ones) are required in lieu of the original Certificate viz:- one for the one Fathom piece with one joining and one End Shackle abstracted, & used to replace a similar piece broken in ship No 48, and one for the remainder of the cable, & I therefore have issued two certificates as follows:-
