It is understood that on No. 48 vessel a fathom length of cable was lost while the vessel was in service, and this was replaced by a fathom length of cable which it had been intended would be fitted in their No. 49 ship. The Builders are desirous of having the certificate No. 58041 amended so that separate certificates can be issued to each ship. The replace cable has now been delivered at the Builders works and as No. 49 vessel is completing early next week, they desire an early reply to their communication. The certificate No. 58041 has been forwarded to Tipton, and it is desired that the Committee's decision should be forwarded there for necessary action.
