Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 15th ultimo intimating that you have decided not to retain the classification of your tug "CHERIFIEN 2" with this Society.

It is noted you believe this action has been taken owing to the repairs which were carried out at Lisbon to the boiler not being satisfactory, and in view of this statement the reports on the case have been looked into and it would appear that the last survey reported from Lisbon was held by the Society's Surveyor in August/September, 1929, when the furnaces were renewed, the bottom manhole flanges repaired and the doors refitted. Several tubes were also renewed and the boiler tested by hydraulic pressure to 170lb. per square inch and found sound and tight.

Since that date the boiler has been submitted to two Annual Surveys, at Casablanca, viz:- in February, 1931, when the only repair effected was the caulking of a leaky seam in the starboard furnace. The boiler was subsequently examined under steam and found tight; and again in February, 1932, on which occasion no repairs to the boiler were effected.

but the bolts of a feed regulator were renewed.

These two surveys at Casablanca were held by the same Surveyor, who was appointed by Lloyd's Agents at that port.

No subsequent reports have been received on the case.

Having regard to the fact that the condition of the boiler, as reported from Casablanca on the two occasions referred to, was satisfactory, it can only be concluded that the repairs carried out at Lisbon were properly done, and your remarks regarding the repairs are not understood.

In view of your decision, however, the case has received the consideration of the Committee, who have accordingly given instructions for the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

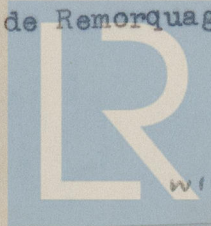
