I beg to acquaint you that a letter has been received at this Office from the Owners of the tug "CHERIFIEN 2" in which they state this vessel is at present being overhauled at Casablanca and that the Boiler Survey, which according to the Society's Rules became due at the end of March last, is to be carried out at this time.

In view of the fact that the Society has no Surveyor stationed in the vicinity of Casablanca, the Committee will be obliged if you will be so good as to appoint a competent and independent Surveyor to hold the inspection in question, on behalf of this Society, upon your receiving a request from the Owners or their Representatives to do so.

For the information of the Surveyor I enclose herewith instructions for carrying out the survey, together with a form for reporting the same, which should be returned to this Office in due course, and I may say that all fees and expenses in connexion with the matter must be paid by the Owners, or their Representatives, and should accordingly be charged by you to them.
