retain the vessel in class.

The General Committee on the 23rd, confirmed the decision
of the Classing Committee of the 17th February, to withdraw vessel's
class and insert (...)

A letter has now been received from the late Owners in
which it is stated :-

"I quite appreciate the fact that you have had certain
"expenses in connection with the part of the survey completed,
"and would like to point out that it is all loss to me.

" I will be pleased if you will consider the matter in this
"light with a view to a very considerable reduction of, or
"cancelling of the fee".

It is submitted for consideration whether in
the circumstances a reduced fee of £2:10:0 might not be accepted
in settlement in this case.
