Nature of Survey

Dimensions :- 550 x 67 x 48 to shade deck.
Scantling Nos:- 106.25 & 58437
Proportions:- Length - 11.45 Depth to Shade Dk.

The ex-German vessel was built by Messrs. Bremer Vulkan in 1914 and was classed with the Germanischer Lloyd.

Plans shewing scantlings have been examined and the vessel approved for the class 100 A. Shade Dk. subject to a satisfactory report being received from the Surveyors after examination of the vessel.

Reports have now been received from the Amsterdam, Grimsby and London Surveyors giving particulars of scantlings which are generally in accordance with ^{those} ~~that~~ approved.

The vessel has been examined in dry-dock, the requirements of a Special Survey No. 3 carried out and satisfactory report received.

The equipment on board has been verified and approved for the figure 1, but it is suggested a stream anchor of proper weight and test be supplied.

The London Surveyors report to complete the Survey draining arrangements from the spaces above the fore peak tank require to be fitted.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to be classed 100 A1 "Shade Dk" subject to draining arrangements from spaces above fore peak being provided.
