The survey for the classification of this vessel was commenced at Amsterdam in April-May 1921, and when the question of the fees was considered at that time a sum of £400 was suggested.

The survey has been advanced from time to time at the end of each voyage and has now been completed. Since May, 1921, however, the cases of several larger vessels have been dealt with for classification, and the fees charged were as follows, viz:-
