1st No. 3 SURVEY PARTLY HELD.

Portion of Survey held, &c.,

The 1st S.S. No.3, due 3,32, has been partly held and to complete same the chain locker requires to be examined.

On the 3rd instant the Naples Surveyor forwarded a letter from the Owners reading as follows:-

"We regret to inform you that our Directing Committee have "decided to withdraw the class of the ss. "CAMOGLI", DESIO" & "GAETA" from Lloyd's Register".

"The decision in question is necessary merely to keep "uniformity of administration with the other vessels of this Company".

The Surveyor stated that he had interviewed the Owners with a view to the question of the withdrawal of this vessel's class being re-considered and no action was taken pending the receipt of a further communication from him.

The same Surveyor now forwards a further letter from the Owners reading as follows:-

"---we have examined your good arguments but we regret having "to inform you that on account of the reasons stated in our letter of the "22nd ultimo we cannot reconsider our previous decisions regarding the "class of the steamers "CAMOGLI", "DESIO" & "GAETA" with your Society".



