
With reference to your letter of the 14th ultimo on the s.s. "CAMOGLI" owned by the "La Meridionale di Nav S. A. of this port, I beg to inform you that having received a letter from the Managing Owners whereby it is understood that they do not wish to retain the vessel's class with this Society any longer. They state further that their decision derives from the necessity of keeping uniformity of administration with all their vessels the majority of them being only classed with the R.I.

I have since interviewed the Supt. Engr. who informs me verbally that the Technical Managing Adviser is at present away from Naples and will be back early next week when the question of the withdrawal of this vessel's class from our Society may be reconsidered

I have in the meantime pointed out clearly and candidly that the decision taken by the Managing Owners appeared to be rather contrary to the interests of the Company they represent and have asked them to reconsider this case.

As soon as a definite reply is received I shall keep you informed at once.
