Dear Sirs,

With reference to my letter of the 12th instant, respecting the fees for the survey during construction of the Hull and Machinery of the s.s. "ROANA" (ex "WAR CRAFT") your first entry report No. 10610, I have to inform you that of the total machinery fee of £144:18:3, the proportion due to your port for the survey during installation on board will be £36: 4: 8, and you will be good enough to see that the necessary entries are now made in your Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.

I may add that of the balance, £36: 4: 7 will be due to the Glasgow Office for the survey of the Boilers, £48: 6: 0 to the West Hartlepool Office for the survey of the turbines, and £24: 3: 0 to the Manchester Office for the survey of the Double Reduction Gears.

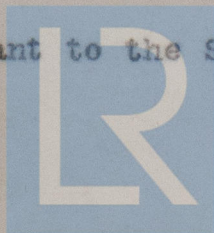
