With reference to your first entry report No. 15642 on the Double Geared Turbines built by Messrs. Richardsons, Westgarth & Co., Ltd., I have to inform you that the Society's Surveyors at Middlesbrough now report that these Turbines have been fitted into the s.s. "ROANA" (ex "WAR CRAFT").

An account for the total fee due for the survey of the machinery during construction has been rendered to the Ministry of Shipping, and the proportion which will be credited to your port for the survey of the turbines will be £48: 6: 0.

You will therefore be good enough to see that the necessary entries are now made in your Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.


