Dear Sir,

In confirmation of the conversation I had the pleasure of having with you over the telephone this morning regarding the fees for the survey during construction of the hull of the s.s. "WAR CRAFT" (now named "ROANA"), Messrs. The Furness Shipbuilding Co's No. 13 vessel, I beg to inform you that following the usual practice an account was rendered to the Shipbuilders for the fees due in this case.

I have, however, received a telegram from the Society's Surveyors at Middlesbrough stating that Messrs. The Furness Shipbuilding Co., have informed them that these fees are payable by the Shipping Controller, and in view of your confirmation of this arrangement in this case, an account for the fees due for the survey of the hull of this vessel is enclosed herewith, and I shall be glad to be favoured with a remittance in settlement at your convenience.

At the same time I may say that I have telegraphed the Society's Surveyors at Middlesbrough informing them that the Classification Certificates may be issued to the Owners who, as explained to you, have been pressing for them, as you stated that this would be quite in order.

I may remind you that an account for the fees due for the survey of the machinery was forwarded to you with my letter of the 12th instant.
