

The Kobe Surveyors now forward a letter from the  
Owners stating that it has been decided to withdraw this  
vessel from the Society's classification. The Surveyors  
add they understand the reason for this decision is that  
the vessel is engaged in local coastwise trade only.

The Classing Committee had the case before them  
on Tuesday, 14th instant, when they decided to give  
instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn  
from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in  
lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners'
