We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, Engines ~~and Boilers~~ of the Vessel No. 188 building by Messrs. *Mitsubishi Zosen Kaisha Ltd* for Messrs. *Japan Salt Transportation Coy.* of 2800 Tons. Length 315 Breadth 46, Depth 25 intended to be Classed *+ 100 A.1.*

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
