

Steel Screw Steamer "SAMBODJA"; No.70979 in Register Book.

871 tons gross. Built: 1911 - 10. Port: Batavia.

Owners: Nederlandsche Indische Tankstoomboot Mij.

Classed: £100AL 3,30 Awn.Dk.with Fbd. S.S.No.3-4,23 S.S.No.1-27 Fitted for oil fuel &c.

The 2nd Special Survey No.2 became due on this vessel in April, 1931.

She has been laid up since that date at Singapore, and the Owners have furnished the usual undertaking.

The case received the consideration of the Classing Committee in April last when, in view of nearly two years having elapsed since the Special Survey became due, the Owners were requested to arrange for the vessel to be generally examined.

They now write as follows :-

"The condition of this vessel is now such that we can assure you that she will no longer be required for our trade, and it is therefore suggested that she should be expunged from the Society's Register Book. We would like to take this opportunity to thank you for the consideration which has been shown in regard to this vessel, and we might mention that efforts are now being made for her sale to be scrapped."

The year of grace expired: 4,32.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Tuesday, 9th instant, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line (5.33), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Owners have been informed accordingly.
