Gentlemen,

I have to inform you that it appears from a first entry report on the new steamer No. 91 recently built by Messrs. Van Vliet & Co., received from the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam, that this vessel is to be towed to your port from Rotterdam, and that to complete the survey the following remains to be done, viz:- the engine and boiler casing tops to be riveted; angles forming the boiler seating to be riveted, and the freeboard to be dealt with and marked on the vessel's sides. The pumping arrangements also require to be completed.

The approved sketches of midship section, profile and pumping plans are forwarded herewith for your guidance, and I shall be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention.

Upon completion of the work a report should be forwarded on Form 8 for the information of the Committee with a view to the classification of the vessel.
