Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyor at Naples has forwarded to this Office your letter of the 9th instant, addressed to him, from which I regret to learn that you have decided not to retain the classification of your steamers "CANOGLI", "DESIO" and "GAETA" with this Society.

In the circumstances I am directed to say that the Committee, who have had the cases before them at their meeting today, have given instructions for the vessels' characters to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, in each case, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I would add that, in view of the withdrawal of these vessels' classes, the records of the freeboards assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draughts, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificates are thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
