S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "FRANCESCA", I beg to inform you that the Committee have had this case under consideration at their meeting today and that, in all the circumstances, they regret they have no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.


