Dear Sir,

We have to confirm your cablegram received
respecting the steamer "ELPIDOPHOROS", now laid up at this
port, reading as follows:-

"ELPIDOPHOROS AS CLASS HAS BEEN EXPUNGED WITH BLACK LINE
CONSIDERED UNDESIRABLE ISSUE ANY CERTIFICATE".

The survey which had been arranged for to-day has
consequently been cancelled and we beg to explain that it was
our intention, seeing that the vessel was unclassed, to issue
a Certificate on form "C" when the survey for seaworthiness
had been completed to our satisfaction.
