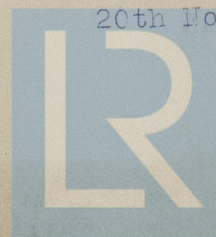
The Special Survey No. 1 on each of these vessels became  
 due in September last.

In reply to enquiry the Owners state that they do not  
 desire to continue the classification of these barges. They add  
 that the "I" barges are used in the Harbour off Talara, Peru,  
 while the "T" barges are used on the Magdalena River, Colombia,  
 and it is therefore not considered desirable to retain their class.

The cases received the consideration of the Classing  
 Committee on Friday, 14th November, when it was decided to give  
 instructions for each vessel's class to be withdrawn from the  
 Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof,  
 indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
