I duly received your letter of the 12th instant relative to the Screw Shaft Survey of the steamer "GREGORY ZINOVIEFF", which became due in January last, and having submitted the same for the Consideration of the Committee at their Meeting today, I am directed to acquaint you that in view of your intimation instructions have been given for this vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.


