H. I am in receipt of your memorandum of the 12th instant intimating you have been informed by the Owners of the steamer "GREGORY ZINOVIEFF" that they are at present unable to make definite arrangements for the screwshaft to be drawn in for inspection, as the vessel is trading in the Far East, but that she is expected to return to Leningrad in April or May next.
