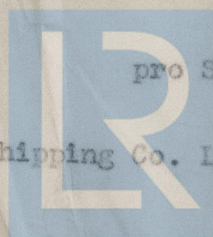
S. I duly received your letters of the 21st ultimo

Committee at their meeting today I am directed to acquaint  
you that, in view of your intimation, instructions have been  
given for these vessels' classes to be withdrawn from the  
Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu  
thereof, in each case, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners'  
request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of  
these vessels' characters the records of the freeboards  
assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding  
draughts, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificates  
are thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
