I am in receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant, forwarding for consideration three plans in duplicate of water tube donkey boilers proposed for Messrs. The Severney S.B. Yard's Nos. 299-300 (M.V. "Alexia Rykoff" & "IAN RUDZUTAK"), and have to acquaint you that these plans will be approved for a working pressure of 5 Kg. per sq. cm. provided the boilers be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing, and the manhole door studs be in accordance with the requirements of Section 16, Clause 3 of the Boiler Rules.
