

Water Tube Boiler for Refrigerator Vessels.

Dear Sir,

I herewith submit for the consideration of the Committee translation of letter received from the Severney Yard and also the

following plans in duplicate:-

- No.26251 - Water Tube Boiler
- 21707 - Detail of Manhole doors
- No.26468 - Position of Boiler in Engine Room.

On account of the trouble which has been experienced with the waste heat boilers in the 2 Refrigerating vessels now in service, the owners wish to fit an extra boiler in each vessel; I have pointed out to the builders that this type of boiler is also most unsuitable for the steam heating purposes, but they say that on account of space restriction they have no alternative.

As these boilers are urgently required they propose to make use of material which they have in stock, some of this material has recently been tested by the Register of USSR and they request that we accept these tests as satisfactory.

The design of the lower drum longitudinal joint is not in accordance with our Rules, but as the pressure is only 5 kg/cm² they would like our approval of the boiler as now shown.

The submission of this boiler has been delayed here on account of the plan of manhole door details and also position of boiler in engine room not being ready, will you therefore please cable a reply so that the work may be commenced as soon as possible.
