I beg to inform you that the Committee have had under consideration today the cases of your Tugs :-

- S. "SAUCY" "ST. DOMINIC"
- "ST. AUBIN" "ST. SAMPSON",

in view of a communication which has been received from the Society's Surveyor at Shanghai that you have decided to withdraw these vessels from classification.

The Committee regret to hear of this decision, which it is understood from the society's Surveyor at Shanghai you have arrived at in consequence of the Society's certificates not now being recognised by the Bureau of Navigation.


