When due

This vessel, built in July last, was fitted with oil engines & was classed subject to 3 new air vessels being fitted in August, as those fitted on board were not constructed under the survey of the Society's Surveyors.

The Owners state that owing to the state of war the vessel is detained in the Black Sea & is awaiting an opportunity to return home to Antwerp. It is submitted that action might be deferred & the Owners informed accordingly.
