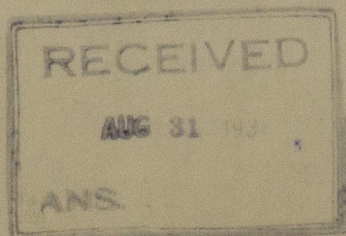
I shall be glad to learn what arrangements have been made for carrying out the Boiler Survey which became due last April.

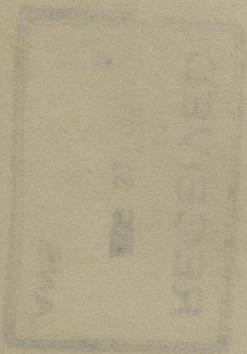
