We wish to acknowledge receipt of your letters of October 17th, in which you advise that the Special Survey No. 1 is due on our "I" and "T" barges.

We do not desire to continue the classification of these barges. We might advise that the "I" barges are used in the Harbour off Talara, Peru, while the "T" barges are used on the Magdalena River, Colombia, and we do not believe it advisable to continue them in class.
