I duly received your letter of the 16th ultimo respecting the Barge "PEDRITO", and have to inform you that the case was duly considered by the Classing Committee on the 30th ultimo, who, in view of the fact that the necessary repairs and renewals to the shell plating of this vessel have been so long delayed, felt they had no alternative but to recommend that the vessel's class should be expunged with a red line.

The case, in accordance with the usual practice, was reported to the General Committee to-day, and they have confirmed the Classing Committee's decision in the matter.


I have therefore to request that you will be good enough to inform the Owners accordingly.
