



I confirm my letter of the 12th instant and have to acknowledge receipt of your telegram of like date.

On receipt of your message I again took the matter of the above vessel with the two Surveyors and after discussing it thoroughly with them a reply was agreed upon, reading :-

"Pedrito surveyors consider repairs can be deferred
 "four months without undue risk" -Larkin-

The Surveyors state that there was very little extra signs of wear and that, with careful navigation, they consider that the craft can be run, without undue risk, for a period of four months, but they state that after that period the renewals and repairs to plating must then be undertaken without fail.
