Gentlemen:-

SUBJECT: BARGE PEDRITO

We refer to your favor of the 12th inst.,  
and our telephone conversation of this morning.

During our conversation we explained to  
you that our busiest season is from January 1st to the  
end of May or 15th of June, depending upon duration of  
the grinding season in Porto Rico and, during this period,  
the barge PEDRITO is kept busy continuously, moving  
molasses from one terminal to another, and also making de-  
liveries to tank vessels, in order to avoid risk of losing  
molasses due to overflow of storage tanks.

In appreciation of our position, as expressed above,  
you were kind enough to promise to cable your Porto Rican  
Agent to authorize us to continue using the barge PEDRITO  
until the end of the crop, when we will give the necessary  
attention to the matter of repairs.
